

TO BE A POLL WORKER

YOU MUST BE:

- A U.S. Citizen
- A registered voter of California
- At least 18 years of age

PRECINCT BOARD POSITIONS:

- Inspector
- Assistant Inspector
- Clerk

HOURS:

Polls are open from 7 a.m.-8 p.m. Poll Workers work from 6 a.m. until approx. 1 hour after the polls close (except for lunch and breaks).

STIPEND:

- \$125 for Inspectors
- \$100 for Assistant Inspectors & Clerks

Precinct Boards usually consist of four Poll Workers (an Inspector, an Assistant Inspector and two Clerks).

Shasta County typically has between 60 to 100+ Precinct Boards for each election.

Registrar of Voters Emergency Response Specialists (R.O.V.E.R.S) are also on-board. They're assigned to several precincts to help resolve any critical issues occurring at Polling Sites on Election Day.
